MEMBERSHIP DETAILS:

Being a member enables you to borrow carriers and other resources from our Babywearing Library, receive babywearing support and help at gatherings and the chance to make connections with other like-minded people. Members also receive a 10% discount from selected products at E-Weez.

All proceeds go towards running the group and upkeep of the library. We always welcome new members and any assistance for the group.

MEMBERSHIP TERMS:

- Annual membership is \$10.00
- Please contact us to cancel membership. This needs to be done in writing.
- Carriers are rented out at \$5.00 per fortnight and a \$50 bond is payable. This is in addition to the membership fee.
- A \$5.00 late fee applies if the carrier is not returned by the due date (unless otherwise arranged). This does not entitle the borrower to another fortnight's rental.
- The maximum rental period is 4 weeks.
- Only one carrier can be borrowed at a time.
- Membership fees, bond and the carrier rental charge need to be paid in full before the carrier will be lent.
- No refunds are given on membership fees or rental charges.
- Borrowers are liable to pay 50% of the replacement cost up to \$100 should a carrier be damaged whilst in their care. The bond may be retained for this purpose.
- Borrowers agree to look after the carrier well whilst in their care and to **not** wash them!

It is your responsibility to ensure your baby is safe while using any baby carrier, including those borrowed from Babywearing Hauraki. For this reason we encourage you to come along to our meetings to learn how to use the carriers correctly. We also lend the carriers with full instructions and a guide to the TICKS rules for safe babywearing.
